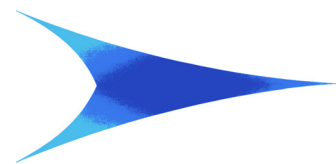

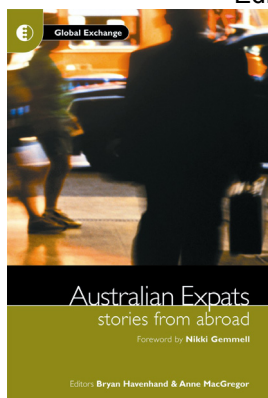

Published by Griffith University in conjunction with ABC Books, this special issue of Griffith Review is built around the theme of the Australian diaspora. It explores the issues surrounding who we are and how we still call Australia home, and features a piece by Southern Cross Group Co-founder Anne MacGregor about the SCG and the challenges of running a virtual lobbying organisation. Contributions are both fiction and non-fiction, encompassing essays, reviews, policy and poems, memoirs and photo reportage. Authors include Professor Graeme Hugo, well-known for his research into emigration from Australia, and Nobel Laureate Professor Peter Doherty, who sets out his "rules" for expatriates returning to Australia. A piece by Macgregor Duncan, Andrew Leigh, David Madden and Peter Tynan considers how different a truly international Australia might be. A total of 33 diverse offerings results in this issue of Griffith Review living up to its established reputation of being "weighty, cheeky, elegant, sceptical and readable".
