Bali Remembrance Service London this Friday

Dear Southern Cross Group Friends,

The Australian High Commission in London has asked us to circulate the announcement below. Although many recipients of this message are not in the UK, we would ask you to bear with us and forward this information on to any expatriate Australians or other interested individuals you might know in the London area.

The Australian High Commission and St Paul's Cathedral will hold a remembrance service this Friday 25 October at 5 pm to commemorate all those who died, or who are still missing, in the tragic events in Bali on 12 October.

Australia is a country in mourning but this service will allow all nationals affected to be united in their grief. This service is for all victims - Australians, Britons, Indonesians and other nationalities who had their lives so brutally cut short and for those who are still missing or injured.

Complimentary tickets to the Service of Remembrance will be available from the Australian High Commission from 10 am, Wednesday 23 October. Tickets are limited to a maximum of four per person and will be issued on a first-come-first-served basis. A passport or other form of identification (preferably photographic) will be required from those collecting tickets in person, and if collecting for other people, their names and addresses will need to be supplied.

Tickets are available from Australia House, The Strand, WC2B 4LA (entrance via Melbourne Ave) Wednesday 23 & Thursday 24 October, between 10 am and 7 pm (or until all tickets are allocated).
