If you do not have access to a fax machine, and want to send a personally tailored text via e-mail to one or more ministers, please send an e-mail to anne@southern-cross-group.org and request a list of all Minister's e-mail addresses/online feedback facilities.

MOST IMPORTANTLY: Once you have sent your fax(es)/e-mails, FORWARD ON THIS E-MAIL and the link above to as many other Australians as you can think of, whether they are overseas or in Australia. The standard fax text can be sent by anyone, regardless of where they are.

Remember: This is an election year. Politicians listen to people whose votes they need. Most Australians overseas no longer have the right to vote, so the more people in Australia we can mobilise, the better!
