Also note that citizenship by descent applicants resident in the following European (and other) countries must now file with the DIAC office at the Australian High Commission in London: Albania, Andorra, Ascension Island, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Canary Islands, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Faroe Islands, Falkland Islands, Finland, France, Germany, Gibraltar and St Helena, Greece, Greenland, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Kosovo, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Palestinian Self-Governing Areas; Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK and Vatican City.

IMPORTANT: Fees are adjusted by the Department on 1 January and 1 July each year.

Applicants filing with a post outside Australia should neatly cross out the words “Australian dollars” and “AUD” on the last page of the citizenship application form and write in the appropriate currency and amount in local currency for the post where they are filing.
