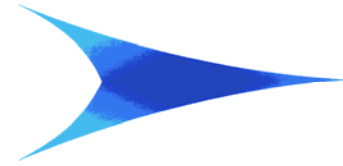

Obtaining Australian Birth, Death and Marriage Certificates

For use with applications for citizenship under the *Australian Citizenship Act 2007*

If you are a **former** Australian citizen planning to apply to **resume** your Australian citizenship, you will need to show evidence that you were previously an Australian citizen. If you were born in Australia, an original full birth certificate will satisfy this requirement. If you do not have an original full Australian birth certificate, you will need to order one from Australia.

If you were **born outside Australia** and had an Australian-citizen natural parent at the **date of your birth**, and will be applying for citizenship by **descent**, you will need to provide evidence that at least one parent was an Australian citizen at the time of your birth. If your parent was born in Australia, an original full copy of their Australian birth certificate will satisfy this requirement.

If you were **born outside Australia** to someone who had **lost their Australian citizenship before your birth because they naturalised in another country**, and you will be applying for citizenship by **conferral**, you will need to provide evidence that at least one natural parent was an Australian citizen before your birth. If your parent was born in Australia, their full original Australian birth certificate will fulfill this requirement. You will also need to provide evidence that your parent lost Australian citizenship before you were born – e.g. their naturalisation certificate.

If you were **married** in Australia and are female, your Australian marriage certificate will also be required as official evidence of any name change. If you were born outside Australia, and your mother was married in Australia, then you will also require her Australian marriage certificate to show her name change.

Note that original documents such as birth and marriage certificates will be returned to you once sighted by the Australian consular authorities.

In Australia, birth, death and marriage records are maintained by the individual States and Territories. The requirements for ordering certificates from each jurisdiction vary, but we set out below basic information that should help you to get started.

Due to privacy laws, there are proof of identity requirements in place in all States and Territories, even if you are ordering your own certificate.
