Dear overseas Australians and friends,

The Australian Preservation Fund (APF) is holding almost AUD\$ 7 billion in unclaimed superannuation moneys. About one in three working Australians are believed to have lost track of their superannuation savings.

You can now inquire with the APF to see whether any of the lost money is yours. Overseas Australians who worked in Australia before going abroad may have contributed to a super fund many years ago and since lost track.

If a possible match is found with your name and birthdate, you will then be asked to fill in a form and send it in to the APF with more information.
